

Squad V Squad Rules

Squad V Squad Sports Scramble is a multi-sport, multi-ball, best of 7 series competition where each game matters more than the last. Two drafted teams face off repeatedly with only one goal, win the game.

Two rival captains will be called upon to assemble their dream team. Those teams will proceed to play a game from a pre-selected sports bank. The losing team picks the next sport. First team to 3 wins takes the trophy.

Voted on Captains

Captains for this competition will be voted on by their peers in a pre-competition poll titled "Who are the Biggest of Rivals?" The two players that receive the most votes will be deemed the captains for the competition.

The role of the captain is to draft the team and choose the next sport in the case of a loss. No management of rostered players is required.

Team Drafts

Prior to competition, the two captains and commissioner will meet in-person to draft teams.

The draft will be in snake format with the first-choosing captain being randomly chosen.

The roster can be made up of rostered FDC or unofficial players, although at least half the roster must be of official FDC players.

The roster has a maximum of 10 players, counting the captain.

If desired, a captain can leave up to 3 roster slots "Open for Pick Up" meaning that a player can be picked up on waivers to join the team during the competition.

Competition Layout

This competition is a best of 7 series, meaning there will be at least 4 game days and up to 7. One game will be played per week, meaning the competition could last 4-7 weeks.

Players are NOT expected to best present every game day. This is a team event, meaning that as long as 1 player from a team's roster shows they are able to play.

The first sport of the competition will be selected by the captains following team drafts. Following the first game, the losing team's captain will choose the next sport.

A sport's ruleset will be defined on game day depending on the amount of players available to participate. The decision will be made mutually between the teams.

Sports Bank

The sports and their available rulesets for the competition are listed below:

Field Hockey

- Hockey played on UAH pickleball courts.
 - First to 3, 5, 7
 - 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 periods

Ultimate

- Ultimate Frisbee played on John Hunt Open Fields.
 - 10, 15, 20, 25, 30 minutes
 - First to 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 points

Penalty Kicks

- Soccer penalty kicks on UAH Lacrosse field.
 - 5, 7, 9 kicks
 - 3, 5, 7, 10 lives
 - Elimination style: You miss a kick, you're out

Kickball

- Kickball played at Oak Park Softball field.
 - 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 innings
 - First to 5, 10, 15 points

Field Goals

- Football field goal kicking at John Hunt Sandpit Field.
 - 3, 5, 7 strikes with accruing distance
 - 3, 5, 7, 10 lives
 - Elimination style: You miss a field goal, you're out

Spikeball

- Spikeball played at John Hunt Sandpit Field.
 - First to 15, combined points
 - First to 15, 20, 25, 30 points
 - Elimination style: After opponents score 5 points, a player is out.

Grass Volleyball

- Volleyball played on a grass court on John Hunt Sandpit Field.
 - First to 15, 21, 25, 30 points
 - Best of 1, 3, 5 sets to 21

Survival Pickleball

- Pickleball where opponents are matched together. If you lose, you're out. Last team standing wins.
 - Score limit of 5, 7, 11
 - 1, 2, 3 lives

Tennis

- Tennis played on UAH Tennis Courts.
 - First to 7, 10, 15, 21 points
 - Best of 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 sets to 5

Dodgeball

- Dodgeball played at Altitude Trampoline park.
 - Best of 1, 3, 5, 7 games
 - First to 10, 15, 20, 25 outs

Wiffleball Match Play

- Wiffleball where a point is accrued based on the winner of an inning.
 - Best of 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 innings

Cornhole

- Cornhole played at John Hunt Sandpit Field.
 - First to 15, 21, 25, 30, 35
 - Best of 1, 3, 5 to 21

PGA BucketGolf

- BucketGolf PGA style where a course is played multiple times.
 - Best score over 1, 2, 3, 4 rounds

Clear Court Basketball

- Basketball where when a player scores, they are removed from play. Removing all players from play is the objective.
 - Best of 1, 3, 5, 7 rounds
 - First to 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 rounds

Nukemball

- Nukemball where opponents keep a ball from hitting their side of the court.
 - Best of 1, 3, 5, 7 rounds
 - First to 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 rounds
 - First to 5, 10, 15, 20, 25 points
